★Conversation Partner System★

International students and Japanese students face each other about once a week. And along with improving daily Japanese language skills of international students through daily conversation, this is a system that aims to deepen friendship with Japanese students of University of Shizuoka.

★International Exchange Room★

There is a community room for international students and Japanese students who are interested in international exchange or a student who interested in study abroad can relax each other. It can be used freely.

★About tuition reduction system★

For students who have difficulty in paying tuition due to financial reasons and have excellent academic performance, or students who are unable to pay tuition due to significant damage to the house of the main household supporter due to natural disasters, depending on the application, the tuition fee may be exempted in full or half or one-third. For example, for international students, the total amount of income for one year is 1.1 million yen or less. Due to the university's budget allocation, the system may be subject to change.

6. About Scholarship

University of Shizuoka will provide scholarships to privately funded international students with excellent grades. There is no obligation to return it.
